Dear Family,

Welcome to First Grade! For many First Graders, this is the first year they have ever experienced homework. Most students are very excited about it! Help your child develop a positive attitude about homework by reviewing the weekly assignment sheet together, setting up a time and a quiet place to do homework, and making sure that homework is completed and returned on time. Encourage your student to become responsible for homework by having him or her pack his or her book bag before going to bed. Establishing a positive routine now will have lifelong effects on your child's academic career! Remember the purpose of homework at this stage is to teach responsibility and reinforce skills and concepts taught in school. Homework assignments should take approximately 15-30 minutes. In addition, LCA requires that students read for a minimum of 15 minutes a night.
